Physiotherapist I

Key Responsibilities

1. Provide home-based rehabilitation service and treatment to clients in the community including all patient care process and handle complicated cases with specialized treatment, conduct educational talks/rehabilitation group training to carers and other service providers, promote and develop the service, etc.;
2. Design, prescribe, supervise, monitor rehabilitation exercise classes and provide health education for clients;
3. Evaluate outcome measures data and prepare rehabilitation service reports;
4. Engage in clinical study and develop clinical guidelines, protocols and patient care process in community and/or cardiac rehabilitation service to enhance the service quality and safety;
5. Supervise staff and ensure teamwork with effective communication and collaboration;
6. Keep abreast of the professional development and issues related to service; and
7. Assist Service In-charge in professional services development and service-related administration, etc.

Requirements

1. A Degree in Physiotherapy or equivalent and a relevant Master Degree;
2. A Certificate of Registration (Part Ia) and a valid Practising Certificate issued by the Physiotherapists Board, Hong Kong;
3. At least 5 years of post-qualification experience in physiotherapy services;
4. Distinct attributes and abilities: supervision and coaching, analytical and logical thinking, problem solving, organizational power, attention to details, interpersonal and communication skills, work independence and a good team player;
5. High command of written and spoken English and Chinese; and
6. Empathy and commitment to patient care, and willing to travel to remote places and villages.
